Condition 3

All stonework and pointing shall be carried out using an appropriate hydraulic lime mortar mix without coloured additives, plasticizers or other additives. Any re-pointing shall be kept to the minimum that is structurally necessary and kept within the confines of the joint and slightly recessed from the face of the brickwork. All brickwork joints shall be finished neatly and cleanly with the mortar brushed slightly back from the arrases. There shall be no buttering-up of joints with mortar flush with the brickwork. The face of the mortar joint should be hammer stippled with a stiff bristled brush prior to the mortar going off to compact the face and slightly expose the aggregate. A sample of the mortar and proposed work (approximately 1 square metre) shall be prepared for inspection and agreed in writing by the local planning authority before the work is carried out.

Condition 4

Details of the proposed external decorative finishes and colour scheme to the metal railings shall be submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority before commencement of works. The development shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details.
