Dear Mr Makin

With reference to the Beech tree in the rear garden of your property I recommend the following works in order let light into the rear garden area.

A lower branch extending to the west over Drewell Road should be pruned back to a small branch as indicated on the appended photograph. The reason for leaving a stub and small branch is to allow the stub to function and take away the potential for decay to enter the main stem which is a possibility if the branch is pruned back to this point.

There is scope for very light thinning of the tree, however not all internal growth should be removed only those branches crossing or rubbing against one another. The opportunity to remove the severed Ivy should also be taken at this time.

I have also attached a location plan for the Tree Preservation Order application.

I trust these works are acceptable to the local authority and if they require further information, please advise them to contact me.
