



**GROUND PREPARATION - GENERAL**

**Preparing for topsoil**  
 Existing topsoil shall be retained to a depth of 100mm above the subgrade level. The topsoil shall be retained by a heavy material wall or other suitable means to prevent loss of topsoil. **Subsoil grading**

**Making up levels**  
 When making up levels in low lying areas to create terraces, it shall be lighty consolidated and left broken up ready to receive topsoil. Imported fill material shall be natural subsoil from the site, concrete or organic material with one dimension greater than 100mm. An imported fill material shall be used for the purpose of leveling areas.

**Supply of topsoil**
