Diagram illustrating the experimental setup for measuring the effect of temperature on the rate of reaction between hydrogen peroxide and potassium iodide.

The diagram shows two test tubes labeled A and B, each containing a solution of hydrogen peroxide and potassium iodide. The test tubes are placed in a water bath maintained at different temperatures.
