Timber frame window with clock feature within the frame.

Leave the window intact and cover up with timber stud partition with lockable access panel.

##### Ceilings - add description

Description of *existing* materials and finishes:

Plaster board with skim finish, painted white.

Description of *proposed* materials and finishes:

After the installation of timber partitions, reinstate locally the plaster board with a skim coat of plaster and paint with two coats of matt emulsion.

##### Internal walls - add description

Description of *existing* materials and finishes:

Brick/Stone with plaster/paint finish.

Description of *proposed* materials and finishes:

DDA Toilet is to be constructed of timber stud partitions with plaster board and paint finish to match the existing wall finishes.

##### Floors - add description

Description of *existing* materials and finishes:

Nonslip vinyl floor covering over tongue + groove floorboards on timber joists.

Description of *proposed* materials and finishes:

Replace, within the new toilet floor area, with non slip tiles over 19mm plyboard. New timber joists / noggins beneath new stud walls.
