Application to remove large Horse Chestnut tree covered by Area A1 of Tree Preservation Order TPO: 236 – Handley Court. The condition of this tree has declined over the last 3 years and it now bears no fruit (conkers). The leaves on the tree start to go brown even before they are fully developed. There is a noticeable lean of the trunk towards the rear and left of my property (approx. NW). An adjacent fence post has also moved indicating movement from the tree. I fear that during the frequent high winds which we now endure the tree is likely to fall and will cause considerable damage to my property or that of a neighbour, or in the worst case scenario loss of life. The tree is approximately 15 metres tall and stands less than 10 metres from my house. The condition of the tree has not only caused concern to myself but also my next door neighbour. My opinion has been backed up by a tree surgeon, Brian, from Stumps Away, 1 Carr Lane, Birkdale, Southport PR8 3EE.
