Damage to tree because of storm. Tree surgeon (Darren Williams, Tree Craft) recommended the tree should come down as one of the main branches was broken and it was dangerous. It was totally broken and resting on tree behind it. The trunk of the tree was rotten and he felt that having taken of the damaged branch the rest of the tree would not survive and would also need to come down.

The tree is in the back garden and broken branch resting on tree in wasteland in Garston Docks
