#### RESIDUAL DESIGN HAZARDS

The designers would draw the readers attention to key residual Construction Health and Safety Hazards that have not been eliminated from the designs shown on the drawings by the design process. These hazards are identified below:

The Contractor is advised that the Statutory Undertakers drawings identify HV cables running along the eastern footway of Speke Road within the immediate vicinity of the proposed access.

Virgin Media apparatus and BT Openreach apparatus are present within the eastern footway of Speke Road adjacent to the proposed access road.

Overhead Street Lighting apparatus is also present along the eastern footway of Speke Road.

In addition to the above there are various other Statutory Undertakers services present in the area. Liverpool City Council's Overseeing Organisation's agent will not be liable for the accuracy of Statutory Undertakers information and the Contractor should verify information prior to commencing works. Copies of all the received Statutory Undertakers drawings are included in the package of works for information. All services must be verified by the Contractor through liaison with the various undertakers and by using detection equipment prior to any excavations taking place, Permit to Work required.

Any construction personnel including operatives intending to construct the designs shown on this drawing should ensure that they have been thoroughly briefed by the Principal Contractor on all Health and Safety matters and have sight of:

- The full Designers and Contractors Hazard and Risk Assessments and Risk Registers.
- The developed Construction Phase Health and Safety plan.
- The Contractors Construction Method Statements.
