All trees to be checked by structural engineer for compliance with current building regulations and NIDC requirements.
 All trees to be Standard rootballed to be planted between Nov - March

SPECIFICATION NOTES

- All planted areas to be kept weed free or treated with Roundup 10 days prior to planting.
- All plants to be healthy, hardened off and with good fibrous root system and to BS. All pot-grown plants to be near "pot bound". All plants to be protected from wind exposure at all times.
- All plants to be pit-planted, with sufficiently large pits to accommodate root system without retaining roots. A minimum size of 450x450x450 mm depth for shrubs and feathered whips, 900 x 900 x 600 mm for selected standard trees and 300 x 300 x 300 mm for ground cover plants.
- Pits to be filled with a 50/50 mixture of topsoil and compost. Growtable fertiliser to be placed in bottom of each pit.
- All planting to be undertaken in accordance with BS. All handling and transport of plants to comply with JCLI Code of Practice. No plants or roots to be exposed to sun or drying winds.
- All plants to be soaked in water for several hours prior to planting and to be well watered in. Evergreen plants to be sprayed with 5600.
- 75mm depth bark mulch to be applied to ground cover and low shrub beds.
- All trees to be secured with sound treated stake 1m long with 600 mm below ground and secured - tied with spacer 300 mm above ground.
- All planting areas to be tidy and weed free upon completion. All pots and rubbish to be taken off site. Plant labels to be removed.
