

Further to our recent discussions and my email below, I attach a covering letter that confirms our requested to "shrink" the current application to cover only the south side of Oriel Street. You will see that we are now referring to this is the "Phase I" application. The "Phase 2" application will follow in the near future once I have received the supporting documents from our wider team.
