




Planting bed with seating



The concept has been generated using the structural grid of the building. Bands of paving and planting extrude from the architecture across the site.

The key design principles and drivers for the landscape are:

- Creation of a pedestrian friendly streetscape;Providing human scale by way of furniture and tree planting against the backdrop of the architecture;
- Continuity in materials across the site in both hard and soft landscaping;
- Texture, colour and movement through ornamental shrub and grass planting softens the interface between the architecture and ground floor.




