






Distant Views to the World Heritage Site

The views chosen were those that are closest to the site and those directed by pre-application discussions.




2. Liverpool from Wallasey Town Hall

Foreground: River, Tidal Margins (low tide)

Middleground: River wall, Waterloo Warehouse (full on), Stanley Dock Warehouses, Victoria Clock Tower, Pier Head Group, Kingsway Tunnel Ventilation shaft, operational docks, wind turbines

Background/Skyline: Everton Ridge, Museum of Liverpool, St John's Beacon, overall cityscape, operational docks, Albert Dock Warehouses, Kings Arena, St Georges Church, Everton Water Tower




3. Liverpool from Woodside Ferry Terminal




Key Landmark Buildings & Key Vistas




