

DESIGN EVOLUTION

The design concept evolved from Liverpool's rich maritime history and close links to New York, taking influence from the Cunard cruise liners and the tall buildings of New York and Liverpool.

The concept diagrams below explore the proportionality and massing of prominent buildings within the skylines of both New York and Liverpool. The tall elegant form of the Empire State building relates closely to the concept diagrams of the Cunard cruise liner, the overall proportions are appealing providing a suitable mounting for the beacon.

The beacon (crown of the building) will become one of the defining design features of the proposal, similar to the Liverbirds aloft the Liver building. Visitors by land or sea will have a 'guidepost' to navigate, drawing you in and around this great city.

Approved massing within Liverpool Waters scheme, outline consent – 126.8m










