External Ramp & Platform

The materials to be used in the new external ramp and platform are chosen to work in harmony with the Liverpool ONE public realm on Colege Lane.

The concept behind the ramp/platform is that it reflects an extrusion of the existing urban realm pattern and materials - rather than a new imposing form or material, i.e. the front edge follows the existing line of darker granite and the materials used in vertical and horizontal plances are to match those adjacent. The use of simple stainless steel handrails and glass balustrades where necessaary again keeps the materials neutral and in line with other parts of Liverpool ONE.

- I. Corduroy Paving in darker granite as per other Liverpool ONE installations (refer to plan for dimensions)
- 2. Contrast Nosings again in the darker granite as a simple but robust solution.
- 3. Main surfaces to be lighter grey granite to match in with the adjacent public realm.
- 4. Darker granite to the vertaical faces of the platform.
