

Zip World Liverpool St John's Gardens Memorial Reflection 18/12/2019

The proposed zip lines over sail St John's Gardens which include permanent and temporary mountments, predominantly from the late Victorian and Edwardian eras. The monuments including Alexander Balfour monument, a merchant ship owner, Regimental monument, a memorial to the King's Liverpool Regiment and William Gladstone monument, who was Prime Minister and born in Rodney Street. The Gladstone monument is also an area dedicated to several other small memorials.

Zip World respect that the use of zip lines above these memorials could be inappropriate at certain times and are therefore have drawn up a plan to cease its operation during certain events and times. Zip World are eager to work alongside community groups so that other events are considered on a case by case basis.
